House System

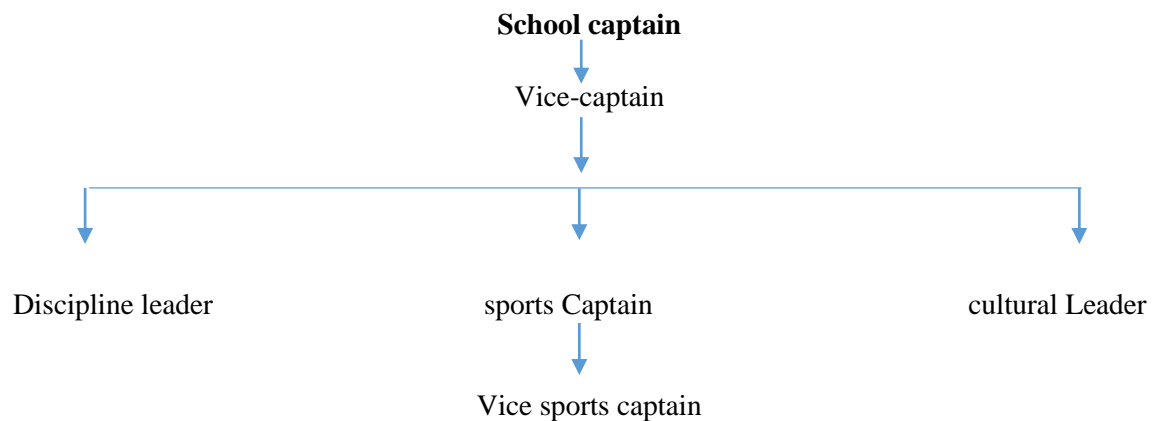

This House system is designed to encourage and increase competition between students and to create a supportive environment.

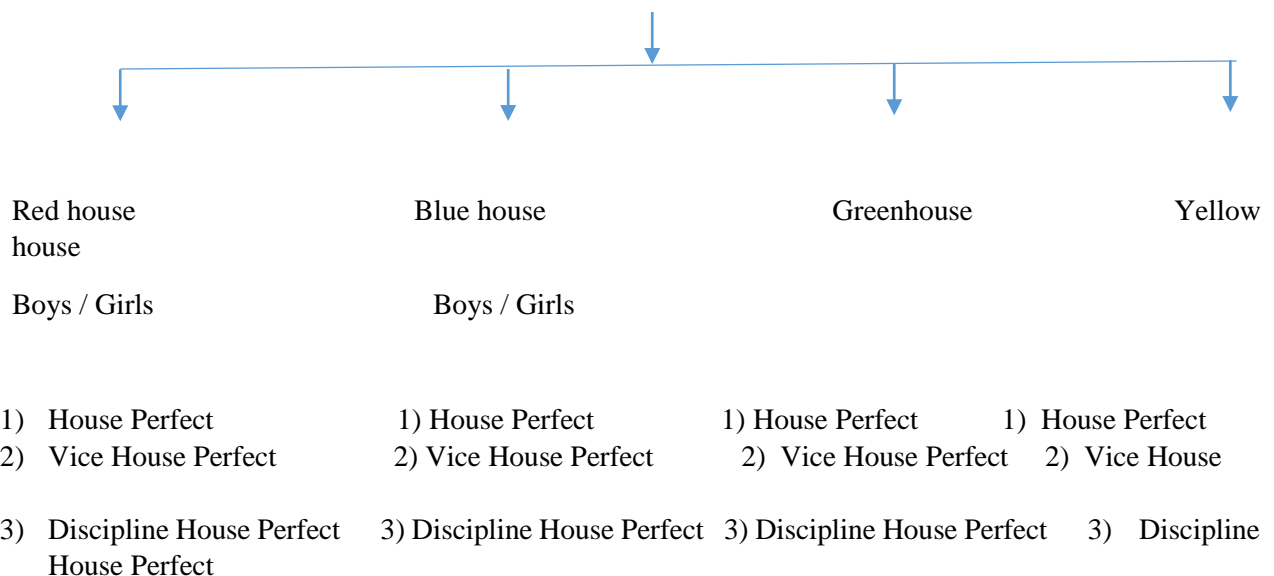
